

First International Tour for *The Cicada and the Ant*

SHERBROOKE, APRIL 27 2015 – On May 5th 2015, the Sursaut Dance Company will begin touring in Mexico with the show *The Cicada and the Ant*. This will be the first time this production tours internationally. Five performances will be given from May 5th to 13th 2015 in four Mexican cities: Aguascalientes, Zacatecas, San Luis Potosi and Estado de Mexico.

“This won’t be the company’s first time performing in Mexico, but it will be a first for *The Cicada and the Ant*. We have some experience touring in Mexico as we did seven performances of *At nightfall* there in the spring of 2014” commented general manager Adam Dymburt.

“*At nightfall* received a very warm welcome during our first Mexican tour. We are confident that our latest choreographic work, *The Cicada and the Ant*, will also touch the Mexican public, both young and old,” added Francine Châteauevert, artistic director and choreographer.

The Cicada and the Ant was presented for the first time in November 2013, and true to the choreographer’s creative process, was reworked in the fall of 2014. The production began touring in Québec in the winter of 2015 and is now ready to take flight to foreign lands.

The Mexican tour will bring the 2014-2015 season to a close for the Sursaut Dance Company, which celebrated 30 years of dance creations for young and family audiences last March.
