

The Sursaut Dance Company on tour in Mexico

SHERBROOKE, MAY 5 2014 – As of May 8th 2014, the Sursaut Dance Company will be on tour in Mexico with *At nightfall*. The production will be presented in five Mexican cities from the 8th to the 16th of May 2014. The company will first perform in Zacatecas, followed by performances in Aguascalientes, Guadalajara and in San Luis Potosi. The tour will end in Terreón, for a total of seven performances.

“The Mexican tour is a great way to disseminate our culture among young audiences abroad. The universal language of dance allows us to transcend barriers and offer performances on an international scale”, relates Adam Dymburt, the company’s General Manager.

Since coming out in 2005, *At nightfall* has been seen by more than 45,000 people. The production has been presented in more than 70 venues and has toured repeatedly in many Canadian provinces, in the United States and in China.

At nightfall tells the story of Auguste, a shoe-maker who is worn out and distraught and who discovers the water forest, where creatures of elusive beauty turn, jump and frolic in total abandon. Their playfulness and fantastical nature exercise an undeniable charm on passers-by who venture into their world.

The Sursaut Dance Company has been dedicated to the creation, production, and dissemination of dance works for young and family audiences for more than 30 years. Sursaut is one of the rare dance companies in the region whose work is diffused on such a broad scale in Canada and abroad.
