

12 PIECE PUZZLE

Elementary School

Pedagogical intent:	Using the solved puzzle, help students find certain words from dance vocabulary as well as from the production <i>The Cicada and the Ant</i> . The teacher invites students to discover the number of dancers appearing in the picture by introducing the notion of trio, which is also found in music, sports, etc.
Target disciplines:	Dance, English Language Arts
Target skills:	To write self-expressive, narrative and information-based texts To use language to communicate and learn To solve problems (intellectual competencies)
Vocabulary:	Level (low, high), support point on the floor, bend, gaze, direction
Other references to QEP:	Essential knowledge (Dance, p. 232, 235) Essential knowledge (ELA, p. 102)
Target groups:	Elementary Cycles 2 and 3
Duration:	Between 20 and 30 minutes
