Pedagogical intent

and procedure:

With this game, the teacher helps students develop an activity they accomplish by exploring a square grid of 3x3 boxes. Once finished, the winner will have aligned 3 identical symbols, horizontally, vertically or diagonally

Two players play against each other. They take turns filling in a box in the grid with the image they are given: cicada or ant instead of the usual O or X.

Target skills:

To write self-expressive, narrative and information-based texts

To use language to communicate and learn

All the words in the grid
